

## FHE CREW BOOSTERS Financial Support Guidelines

We understand that crew is an expensive sport and we do not want any athlete to be turned away due to financial constraints. Unfortunately, the Crew Boosters also has limited finances and can only do so much for families requesting assistance.

- → The Crew Boosters will work out a payment plan with families to pay the full amount of dues, if more time would be helpful.
- → If making the full dues payment, even over time, isn't financially possible for your family, the Boosters can offer some financial assistance. In order for us to give financial support, we require your help in our fundraising efforts.
  - ◆ To be considered for some level of financial support, parents need to agree to the guidelines below and follow through with them **during** the sporting season for which the request is being made.
  - ◆ If all of the guidelines are not met, the athlete will not be eligible for financial assistance in the future, and may lose the right to row for the remainder of the season, depending on the circumstances.

## **Guidelines for Financial Assistance from the FHE Crew Boosters:**

- 1. The athlete and/or parents must participate in **two** fundraisers during that season. Fundraisers vary each year, and parents will be notified in advance of what the opportunities are for that year. In the past, they have been things like school concession shifts which designate the crew team, Vertical Raise, and ergathon sponsors.
- 2. The athlete will not have any unexcused absences during the season.
- 3. The athlete will abide by all team rules of respect and sportsmanship.
